We are committed to making sure that our website is accessible to all. By working with others, we are continually improving our site, applying the relevant accessibility standards and good practice so our site works better for everyone.

Supporting accessibility

We make sure that accessibility is supported in our organisation by:

- Including accessibility as part of our broader equity, diversity, and inclusion programme and our Strategic Equality Plan 2024-2028.
- Considering accessibility as part of our <u>Strategic Plan 2024-2027</u> priorities, to help people and services to use technology in ways that work for them.
- Consulting and engaging with people who have disabilities to help us shape our website, organisation, and service delivery.
- Work with experts to improve both the digital and overall accessibility of our organisation.

Accessibility standards

We regularly audit our website to make sure that we meet the accessibility requirements set out for us as a public body.

This means that our website must meet the Web Content Accessibility Guidelines 2.2 AA.

We are improving our accessibility by:

- Looking at ways we can provide a wider range of accessibility tools for our website and making sure these are visible for people to use.
- Reviewing the overall design of our website to make sure that people can find what they need more easily.

Non-digital accessibility

We know that accessibility is our whole team's job. This means that we must work together to make sure as many people as possible can get involved in any of our activities and use any of our services.

We will continue to make sure that:

- Everyone in Llais thinks about how people might access and use our services from the beginning.
- Our staff and volunteers understand accessibility, and how to avoid accidentally making things harder than they should be.
- Those who we work with to carry out our activities understand accessibility too. We will work with them to build this into the products and services they design or provide for us.
- We are completing Integrated Impact Assessments that show we have considered the accessibility of our policies, processes, and practices.
- Explore new ways of working and reasonable adjustments so our staff and volunteers can succeed in an inclusive workplace.
